

The water cycle collage

You will need:

 Art and craft materials, e.g., coloured thin cardboard/ craft paper, textas, crayons, pencils, paints, cotton wool, cellophane


Optional:

 You may even like to go for a walk outside and collect some sticks, bark, leaves, dirt, pebbles/small rocks

Steps:

- Draw/sketch your own water cycle image onto a piece of paper or cardboard - think about evaporation, condensation and precipitation. Or you can use our diagram as a template and build your collage onto it.
- 2. Using the art and craft materials you have gathered, make a colourful collage to illustrate the stages of the water cycle.

Ideas: You could use cellophane for the water, paint for the rain drops, cotton wool for your clouds and yellow cardboard for a sun. If you found some, you could glue on your leaves and sticks to make a tree? Or maybe you have some other fun and creative ideas?
